RESOLUTION NO. 15-3000

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF LAKE HAVASU CITY,
MOHAVE COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE VISION 20/20 PLAN OF THE
AMERICA'S BEST COMMUNITIES QUARTER-FINALIST APPLICATION TO
ASSIST WITH THE REVIVAL OF THE LOCAL ECONOMY AND IMPROVED
QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE CITIZENS OF LAKE HAVASU CITY

RECITALS: Frontier Communications, DISH Network, The Weather Channel, and CoBank created a three year competition called "America's Best Communities" in an effort to help America's small towns and cities grow stronger and more vibrant, as well as to inspire innovation and foster sustainable local growth. The community ultimately named "America's Best Community" will receive three million dollars to assist with the revival of the local economy and improved quality of life. As a quarterfinalist in the "America's Best Communities" competition, Lake Havasu City, through the Havasu Future Foundation, received fifty thousand dollars to stimulate the City's economic prosperity.

On August 22, 2015, the community gathered at a Town Hall meeting to support and develop a revitalization plan called Vision 20/20 that focuses on five Pillars for Change (Economic Development & Job Creation, Education & Talent Supply, Tourism & Place Development, Water, and Community Engagement), which are instrumental in transforming the future of Lake Havasu City. The City's role in all five Pillars for Change is vital to the success of the plan, and the City commits to support the goal to change the current economic path to achieve the Vision 20/20 plan. Fulfillment of this competition, in April 2017, will result in the generation of sustained economic momentum which will strengthen Lake Havasu City for many years.

IT IS RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of Lake Havasu City, Arizona, commit to support the Vision 20/20 Plan devised through the America's Best Communities competition to ensure revival of the local economy and improved quality of life for the citizens of Lake Havasu City.




